## BIBLE BIT:

## CREATIVE CRAFT!

*Create your own field*



1. *Cut one of the longest sides of an old cereal packet and sellotape up the shorter sides to make a field. Alternatively, you could use an old box.*
2. *Draw some animals and plants (e.g. sheep, cattle, flowers) either on card or paper, whatever is to hand.*
3. *Cut out the animals and flowers etc and decorate them by colouring them or sticking cotton wool or tissue for wool, petals.*
4. *Place your animals and flowers in your field.*
5. *You could use some lego characters or toy farm animals if you have them too.*

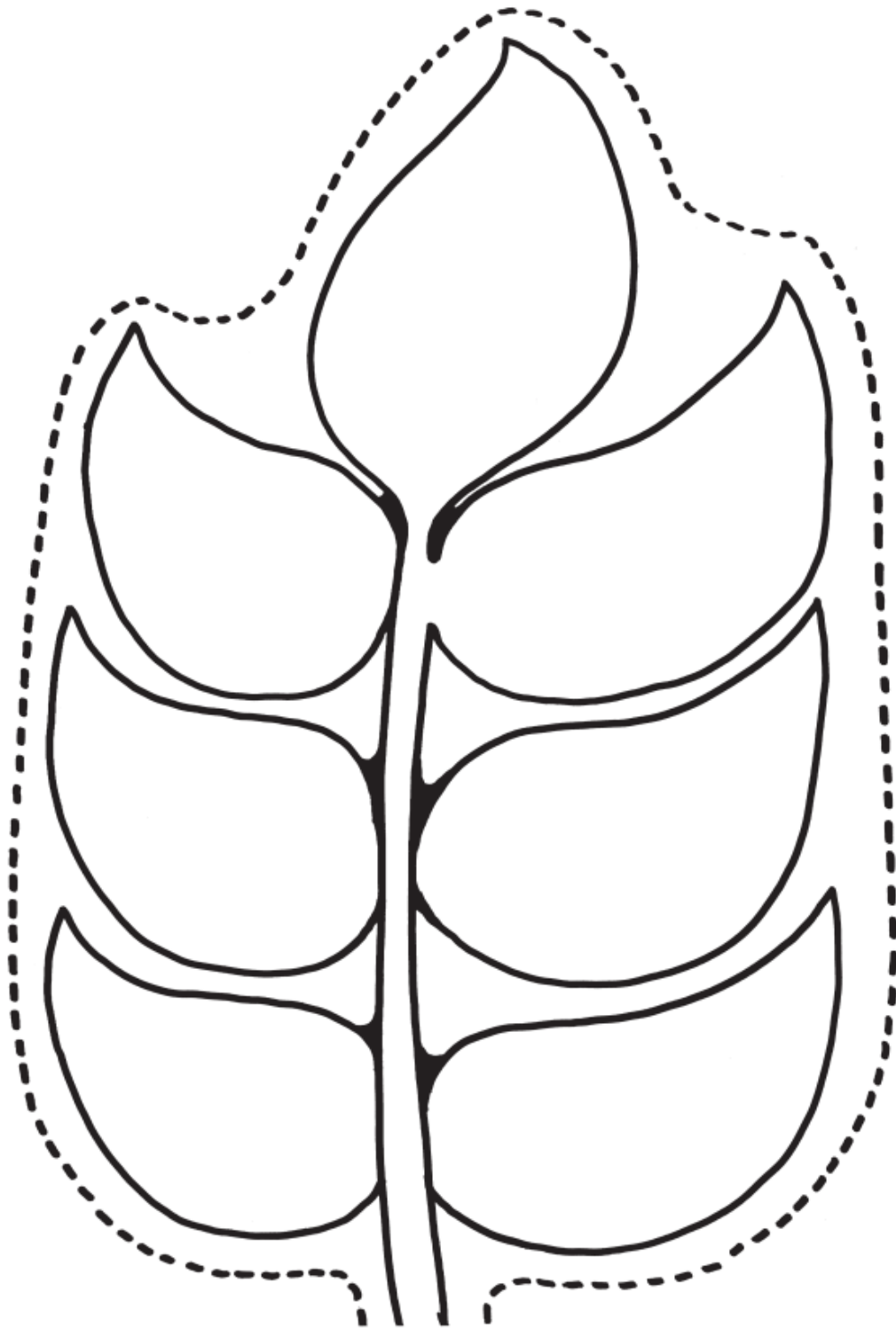
*Cut out this ear of corn and fill it with your prayers – whatever is on your mind:*
