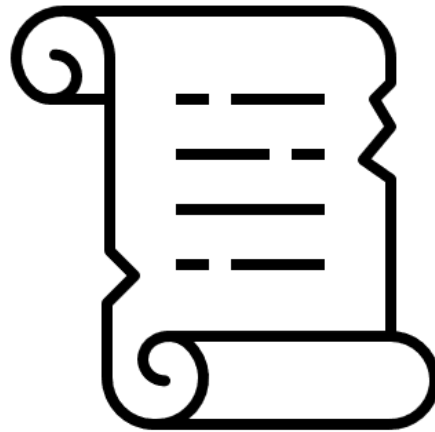
Jeremiah 36 International Children's Bible (ICB)

### Jehoiakim Burns Jeremiah's Scroll

The Lord spoke his word to Jeremiah. He said "Jeremiah, get a scroll. Write on it all the words I have spoken to you about Israel and Judah and all the nations. Write everything I have spoken to you since Josiah was king until now.

So Jeremiah called for his assistant Baruch. Jeremiah spoke the messages the Lord had given him. And Baruch wrote those messages on the scroll. Then Jeremiah told Baruch to go to the Temple of the Lord on a day when the people are giving up eating and to read to all the people of Judah from the scroll. "Perhaps they will ask the Lord to help them" He said. So Baruch did everything Jeremiah the prophet told him to do. He read aloud the scroll that had the Lord's messages written on it. He read it in the Lord's Temple.

A Royal assistant and the King's Officers from the palace heard the words that



Baruch read from the scroll. They became afraid. They wanted to change their ways and ask God to help them. The officers knew they needed to tell King Jehoiakim of Judah about the scroll. But they knew he would be angry and want to hurt Baruch and Jeremiah. The Officers told Baruch to take Jeremiah and Hide. "Do not tell anyone where you are hiding" They said.



The Officers showed the scroll to King Jehoiakim. He was not afraid like the Officers had been. Instead He cut the scroll in two and burned it, because he did not like what he had heard. Then he ordered his officers to arrest Barucha and Jeremiah the prophet, but God kept them hidden and safe.

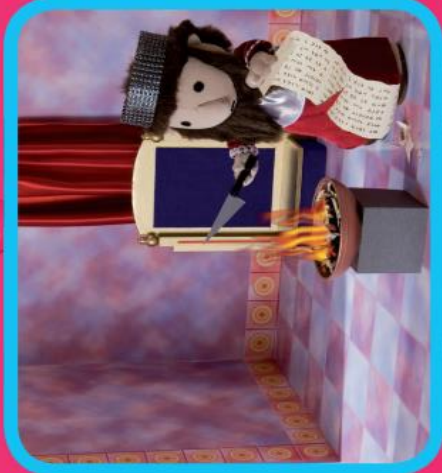

### Make a scroll

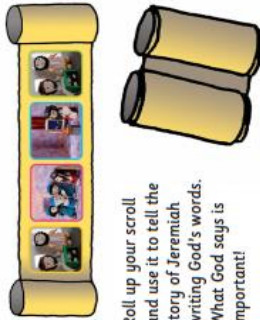
**What you need:**
