Hello everyone! It's Revd Kyla. How are you today? It is such a beautiful day I thought I would send you a message to tell you all about Pentecost.

Today is a very special celebration for Jesus' Church – some call it the Church's birthday! This is because it was the first time that Jesus' friends came together and started to really talk about him to all the people around them, telling them how amazing he is and how much he loves them. A bit like we do at St. Mary's when we are together with you!

Some people put up lots of red balloons to decorate their church at Pentecost. We have put up all your lovely pictures on the railings outside St. Mary's for everyone to see as they are walking past. It looks so pretty!

Some churches sing "Happy Birthday!" to the church (it is very, very, very old, so we couldn't make a cake...it would need too many candles!) Can you sing happy birthday to the church today?

Something else we celebrate is how the Holy Spirit came down from heaven to be with us and is still here helping us to be kind, and teaching to help each other. The Holy Spirit was sent by Jesus to be with us.
